President Elect Report: Jen Valente

- Once voting is complete in May Jen will have a pre planning meeting. Ideally, everything would be on the calendar before January.
- The board needs clarification on announcing to membership board meetings and times. The five-day announcement prior to a board meeting to membership where membership does not

have a vote. The meetings are currently not open to membership via zoom. When and were are we announcing it..

First Vice President Report: Danielle Pojar

Treasurer's Report: Maggie Harma

- Axe throwing was \$316.68 over budget due to food and drinks.
- \$260 worth of cookies for membership orientation.
- I am proposing that we take \$500 from each president and president elect travel funds for a total of \$1,000 to be moved into our "misc" line item on the budget. They currently have a budget of \$3,240 each for travel. There is a separate line item for Leadership 360. So far this year, Jen has not used any of her travel budget. Michele has used \$314.62.
- Revised Travel Budget 2022 for President/President Elect \$2,240 of which \$1,925.38 remains uncommitted
- Revised Misc. Budget 2022 \$1,000 of which \$423.32 remains uncommitted
- Bank balances as of 2/28 were \$7,163.34 savings and \$10,074.18 checking for a total of \$17,237.52. March statement has not yet produced.
- Most of what is on our books for March was Strategic partner income, Realtor income, deposit for Tiger's bus trip (tickets and bus), and deposit for December Chicago bus trip.
- Jaime Flees has agreed to be our event sponsor for \$250 for April event. We will take a loss
 on the event since the board voted to make this a free event. I won't know the total until we
 get closer so we know how much lunch will cost.
- I am proposing that we put the loss again in our MISC line item in the budget.
- I have created our Bill highway account. There is a training on April 7th that I would STRONGLY suggest all board members sign up for. At this point, I do not recommend using Bill highway for anything other than the National Dues. Any "new" software always has kinks and I want to see what other organizations like and dislike about it before we commit to utilizing it to its fullest capacity.
- I have been in contact with Trey Junkins to do our taxes. Nonprofits have until May 15th. He is getting through April deadline for personal tax returns before he starts on ours. He will send me a quote once he has had a chance to review. We have budgeted \$225 for tax preparation.
