

- National Liaisons shall oversee, support and promote the work of the Women's Council in their respective regions, work directly with state leadership, and local leadership (if there is no state network) and report to the Leadership Team to further the mission of the Council in such matters as may be assigned to them.
- Chair the regional caucuses at National Meetings to conduct regional business affairs and exchange information
- Identify opportunities and/or challenges within the region and assist wherever possible
